



MUSIC

1. Music is not permitted within 50 metres of any building. The Club reserves the right to play music at special events around buildings.
2. Music is permitted at the Practice Facilities ONLY WITH THE USE OF HEADPHONES with the volume at a level that cannot be heard by others at any point on or near the practice facilities.
3. Members and guests are permitted to listen to music via personal and portable speakers as long as the volume of the music cannot be heard by other groups or the private residences around the golf course. In keeping with the etiquette and courtesy of the game, please consult other members of your group prior to teeing off and before turning on any personal device with amplified music. When approaching congested areas, tee boxes and green complexes with other golfers around, music must be turned off.
4. Music is NOT permitted during competitive play for all Club tournaments. The Men's or Ladies Executive can make a local rule allowing for the use of music for certain events such as team scrambles. Corporate tournaments may play music at their discretion during their event.
