BOARD MEETING June 13, 2023

Correspondence

There was no correspondence received from TVGC Membership.

Finance & Business Development (Tracy Bertsch, Roberta MacKenzie, John Burke, JD Scheller)

- June 2023 Key Performance Indicators (KPI's):
 - 6272 rounds played in June, an increase of 278 rounds from June 2022. Members played 3044 rounds for 49% of the total rounds played.
 - Course usage rate was 70% up from 67% in June 2022.
 - o Average spend in the Pro Shop was \$16.45, down from \$16.89 in June 2022.
 - Average spend in Food & Beverage was \$19.19, down from \$20.11 in June 2022.
 - Course & Grounds labour per round was \$7.18, up from \$6.90 per round in June 2022.
- As at the end of June 2023:
 - Financials to the end of June 2023
 - Revenues 1.6 M Budget 1.5 M 2022 1.5 M
 - Expenses 1.0 M Budget 1.2 M 2022 1.0 M
 - Net Income 522K Budget 372K 2022 424K
 - Financially we are continuing to make much needed progress. Capital expense to date excluding capital leases is 103K.
 - We are continuing to meet our financial ratio obligations under our borrowing agreement.
- John & J.D. will be meeting to discuss the feasibility of creating a Capital Expense Account for year-end budgeting.
- A new policy for Blue Flag usage on power carts has been implemented. Policy Manual has been updated & posted to the Member Website.

- A Mini Strategic Planning Session was held on June 14th. Course & Grounds Vision, Mission and Pledge were tweaked and future plans were developed.
- There is a meeting planned with Les Furber to discuss the Hole 10 project.
